This installation requires:

- · Lowering of exhaust
- May require panel trimming (dependent on vehicle model / trim level)

Periodic inspection of the trailer hitch should be performed to ensure all mounting hardware remains tight and structural components are secure.

To help prevent damage to the product or vehicle, refer to the specified torque specifications when securing hardware during the installation process.







ASSEMBLY







Step 1

Lower the exhaust by removing the two rear-most exhaust hanger rods on both sides from the two rubber isolators.

The exhaust will be reinstalled in step 3.

Note: Use a stand to support the exhaust and prevent any damage.





Step 2

Raise the hitch over the exhaust on the passenger side first, if applicable. Gently pull the bumper facia rearward if needed, and raise the hitch into position. Install the six M10 bolts (#1) and six conicaltoothed washers (#2) into the existing vehicle weld nuts using a 17mm socket.

Torque all M10 hardware to 33.4 ft-lbs. using a torque wench, 17mm socket and extension, if needed.





Step 3

Reinstall the exhaust removed in step 1.
